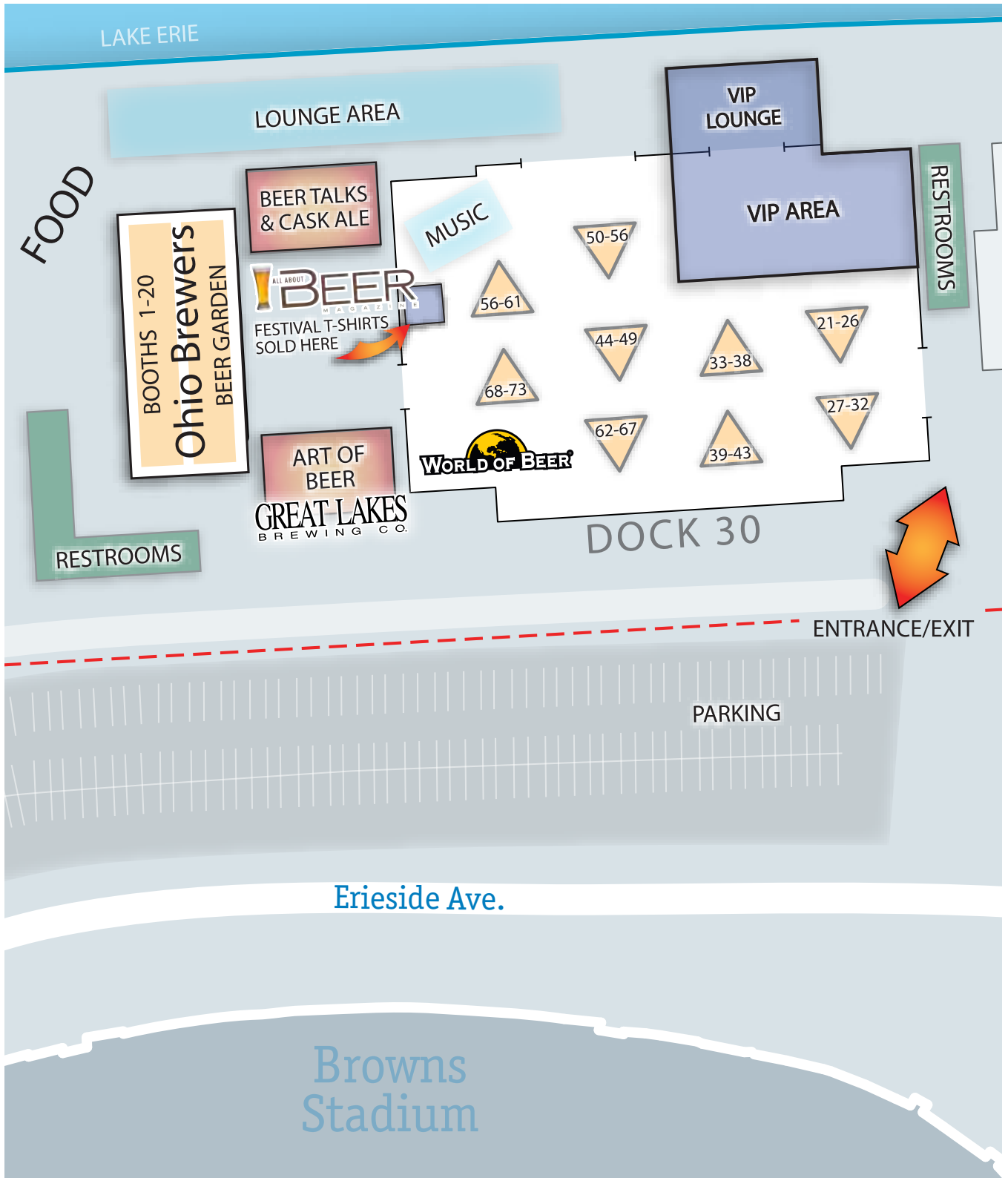

This American session ale packs a lot of hop and malt flavor into a refreshingly lower-alcohol brew, making it the perfect beer to have on hand when you have a little history to make.

Kentucky Light - *Kölsch* - Kentucky Light is a full flavored Kölsch style ale true to form of the German beer originating in Cologne, Germany. While light in body, this beer is full in flavor and easy to enjoy with a lively aroma and a crisp, zesty finish. A specialized yeast, said to be the life force in beer, is the single greatest flavor contributor to this remarkably smooth and flavorful microbrew.

Kentucky IPA - *American IPA* - Kentucky IPA is a deliciously hoppy, golden-hued American IPA. It has bright citrus flavors and sweet floral aromas which come from liberal dry-hopping with American hops.

Kentucky Bourbon Barrel Ale - *Ale* - Award-winning Kentucky Bourbon Barrel Ale is a unique sipping beer with the distinctive nose of a well-crafted bourbon. Kentucky Ale is aged for up to six weeks in freshly decanted bourbon barrels from some of Kentucky's finest distilleries. Subtle yet familiar flavors of vanilla and oak are imparted to this special ale as it rests in the charred barrels. Pleasantly smooth and robust, Kentucky Bourbon Barrel

Ale may also be served as an aperitif or after-dinner drink.

Hints of sun toasted grain, toffee, and fruity esters compliment the mellow, noble hop aroma.

Hop Ottin - *India Pale Ale* - Hops are the cornerstone of India pale ales around the world, and Hop Ottin' IPA is no exception. Handcrafted with copious amounts of Columbus and Cascade, this beer is a showcase of bright citrusy aromas, bold grapefruit and pine-like flavors, and the resinous bitterness that hop heads crave.

Oarsman - *Session Ale* - Designed as a flavorful session beer, Oarsman Ale uses a classic German brewing technique to impart a light, refreshing tartness. Oarsman Ale grew out of a desire to explore the tradition of session beers, trading intensity for finesse while still creating a worthwhile experience for the taster. The grain bill includes a healthy portion of wheat, while citrusy hops lend bright notes to the aroma.

Midwestern Pale Ale - *American Pale Ale* - Brewed with barley from Bell's Brewery's farm in central Michigan, Midwestern Pale Ale stands apart from the model of completely hop-dominated pale ales, offering a noticeable degree of malt body to counter the hop bitterness. A blend of floral and herbal hop notes provide the aromatic and flavor highlights, alongside the distinctive contribution of a house ale yeast. A crisp bitterness finishes the experience without being harsh.

2012 IPA - *American IPA* - This India pale ale is brewed with generous amounts of hops, then dry hopped. Its citrus, yet smooth character pairs well with spicy foods.

Cloud Nine - *Wheat Ale* - Cloud Nine is a spiced white wheat. It is balanced nicely with lemon-grass, coriander, bitter, and sweet orange peel. Its spices do not overpower the pallet. A fresh slice of

orange makes a nice garnish, and it matches very well with lighter foods like fish or grilled chicken.

Plumber's Crack - *American Pale Ale* - Brewed using Liberty, Mt. Hood, and Perle hops, this unique brew has a pleasant "green hop" aroma. A touch of minty bitterness gives Plumber's Crack a nice finish.

Summer Ale - *American Pale Wheat* - Crisp and tangy with refreshing lemon peel and a hint of pepper from rare Grains of Paradise. Golden, hazy and thirst quenching, this American wheat ale balances bright citrus, Noble hops and spice for a lively brew that's perfect on any summer day.

White Water IPA - *American IPA* - This flavor-packed brew draws inspiration from two distinct styles: The white ales of Belgium and American IPAs. But while a fusion of the two, it's far more than the sum of both, exhibiting a harmony of crisp wheat, bright pine and citrus flavors, and just a hint of orange peel.

Angry Orchard - *Cider* - This crisp and refreshing cider offers sweet apple notes up front with a subtle dryness at the finish for a balanced cider taste. A hint of Fuji apples adds a layer of complexity brings out a fresh apple aroma and slightly sweet, ripe apple flavor.

Grumpy Monk - *Belgian IPA* - The long-held brewing traditions of Belgian monks aren't meant to be broken. Yet, to the monks' dismay, the distinctive character of Belgian yeast with its spicy clove and fruit notes can be reimagined when combined with the brazen hop character of an IPA. These hops impart a citrusy, piney and earthy flavor that's balanced by a roasted malt sweetness for a complex and playful brew.

Third Voyage - *Double IPA* - This unique double IPA takes the style's origins of brewing for a long voyage a step further. Inspired by the indomitable Capt. James Cook, whose third voyage made him the first to navigate a treacherous route from England to New Zealand to the Pacific Northwest. Using Cascade hops from each of these regions,

Boston Beer Co. created a brew that's citrusy, earthy and full of bold character.

Imperial White - *Imperial Witbier* - This golden concoction begins with the soft sweetness of its witbier roots with hints of orange and citrus. Yet these familiar flavors are taken to the next level with an exotic blend of spices reminiscent of medieval brewing. From coriander to dried plum and anise, the spices combine with a bolder, richer flavor for a warm, spicy brew that's smooth and refreshing.

Witte - *Belgian Wheat* - Traditional Belgian-style wheat, flavorful, soft and hazy.

B.P.A. - *Belgian Pale Ale* - Pale and hoppy with notes of citrus and tropical fruits.

Ommegang Abbey - *Dubbel* - Rich, fruity and aromatic burcundian brew.

Gnomegang - *Belgian Strong Pale* - In appearance, Gnomegang is a rich, translucent gold, with a big, fluffy white head. The high carbonation is readily apparent. The nose focuses on distinctive clove aromas, combined with yeasty fruitiness typical of Chouffe beers. Flavors include ripe fruit, clove, light caramel, non-cloying candy sweetness, smooth maltiness and well-balanced hopping. Mouthfeel offers a big, round body with full, fine carbonation. The finish is dry and warming, lingering gracefully.

Brooklyn Lager - *American Amber Lager* - Brooklyn Lager is amber-gold in color and displays a firm malt center supported by a refreshing bitterness and floral hop aroma. Caramel malts show in the finish. The aromatic qualities of the beer are enhanced by dry-hopping, the centuries-old practice of steeping the beer with fresh hops as it undergoes a long, cold maturation. The result is a wonderfully fla-

vorful beer, smooth, refreshing and very versatile with food.

Brooklyn Silver Anniversary - *Doppelbock* - The Brooklyn Brewery is celebrating its 25th anniversary this year, saluting its beginnings with a special doppelbock version of the Brooklyn Lager introduced in 1988.

Sorachi Ace - *Golden Farmhouse Ale* - Brooklyn Sorachi Ace is a classic saison, a cracklingly dry, hoppy unfiltered golden farmhouse ale, but made entirely with now-rare Sorachi Ace hops grown by a single farm in Washington. It is fermented with a special Belgian ale strain, and then add more Sorachi Ace hops post-fermentation. After the dry-hopping, the beer emerges with a bright spicy lemongrass/lemon zest aroma, backed by a wonderfully clean malt flavor.

Brooklyn Blast - *Imperial IPA* - The Brooklyn Brewery brews its beer in New York, about halfway between the hop fields of the Pacific Northwest and the hop fields of Kent, England. So it uses earthy English hops to build the foundation and bright citrusy American hops to bring the noise in this rambunctious IPA. British Maris Otter and German Pilsner malts lends solidity, balance and breadly flavors to brace up a beer that's beautifully hoppy, strangely quaffable and oddly compelling. Minerally hop bitterness is followed by a shock wave of flavor and aroma. You won't even know what hit you.

Rat Tail Ale - *American Amber Ale* - Bitterness and aromatic hops dominate this American amber ale with a strong, full malt backbone to match. When you taste this you know your drinking a beer inspired by the adventurous West Coast ales.

Pride of Cleveland - *Czech style Pilsner* - The new P.O.C. is a European-style Pilsner with unsurpassed flavor and body. Just enough pale malt to give off complex, floral, grainy notes supported by handfuls of authentic East European hops (even in the storage vessel) to bring a deep-rooted bitterness to the palate.

Rat Rampage - *Imperial IPA* - A hoppy imperial India pale ale.

Rye Rat - *Bourbon Aged Ale* - A special barrel-aged ale from the brewery in Madison, OH.

Cinq Cents - *Belgian Tripel* - Of a golden color, the Trappist beer combines sweet and bitter in a rare balance. The beer's aroma felt in the mouth comes from the hops' perfumes: Above all, they are fruity touches of Muscat grapes and raisins, even ripe apples. This traditional Belgian beer is best savored fresh at a temperature of from 42.8-46.4°F.

Premiere - This Trappist beer possesses a beautiful coppery color that makes it particularly attractive. Topped with a creamy head, it gives off a slight fruity apricot smell from the fermentation. The aroma felt in the mouth is a balance confirming the fruit nuances revealed to the sense of smell.

Pious Monk - *Munich Dunkel* - This dark lager was first brewed in Munich, Germany, more than 150 years ago. This version is fairly dark in color, but don't be afraid, the Pious Monk Dunkel is the perfect example that not all darker beers are strong. The body is surprisingly melow and the alcohol content is low.

It has a wonderful clean and roasty aroma and finishes crisp and clean as a lager should.

Thunderhop - *Double IPA* - The Church Brew Works uses three varieties of American hops in the brewing process. The color is copper to amber. The aroma is noticeably hoppy due to the use of Sterlings in the dry hop process. You will also pick up a complexity from fruit-like esters. The body is big and malty with some caramel sweetness. You won't have to wait long for the finish, it comes thundering in with intense bitterness.

Rocket Cow - *Milk Stout* - Cream stout made with caramel and roasted malts, with added milk sugar to keep you in good health. Rich and creamy with a surprisingly light body. Not for the lactose intolerant.

Black & Tan - *Hybrid Ale* - Dark brewed porter with Premium beer. Rich and dark in color, it has a well-balanced flavor with hints of caramel and coffee.

Lord Chesterfield Ale - *American Pale Ale* - Brewed with select hops, its distinct robust flavor is derived from a delicate combination of sweet maltiness and lingering herbal bitterness.

Porter - *Robust Porter* - This porter calls for a generous portion of caramel and dark roasted malts, which deliver a rich full-bodied flavor and creamy taste with slight tones of chocolate evident in every sip.

Lager - *Amber Lager* - Famous for its rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor.

Light Lager - *Light Lager* - Appeals to those who don't want to sacrifice character for a low-calorie light beer.

60 Minute IPA - American IPA - 60 Minute is brewed with a slew of great Northwest hops. A powerful but balanced East Coast IPA with a lot of citrusy hop character, it's the session beer for hardcore enthusiasts.

Festina Peche - Berliner Weiss - A refreshing neo-Berliner Weiss, Festina Peche is available in 4-packs and on draft during the sweaty months. Sadly, there are only a few breweries left in Berlin still brewing the Berliner Weiss style, which is characterized by its intense tartness (some say sour). There were once over 70 breweries in Berlin alone making this beer.

Oak Barrel Stout - American Sweet Stout - We use smoked and peated malts to create an intricate malt foundation. Dry hopping with vanilla beans and oak chips pushes the depth of this stout's flavor spectrum even further.

Hop Mountain - American Pale Ale - A rich, red ale made in the American pale ale style, Hop Mountain has strong hop character, medium-dry finish and floral hop aroma.

Duvel - Belgian Strong Pale Ale - Duvel is still seen as the reference among more full-bodied lagers. Its bouquet is lively and tickles the nose with an element of citrus which even tends towards grapefruit, thanks to the use of only the highest-quality hop varieties. This is also reflected in the flavour, which is beautifully balanced with a hint of spiciness.

Duvel Tripel Hop - Belgian IPA - By using three—instead of two—hop varieties to brew, Duvel obtains additional hop aromas and an increased bitterness. The typical Duvel palate is enriched with Sorachi Ace hops, providing fresh notes of citrus and mint. Sorachi Ace hops are added again during dry hopping, extracting additional hop aromas into the beer.

Mogabi Hoppy Wheat Ale - Wheat Ale - A crisp, filtered American wheat beer, Mogabi Hoppy Wheat Ale is dry-hopped with Amarillo for a citrusy bite.

Three Frogs IPA - American IPA - Easy drinking despite it ABV, Three Frogs IPA is aggressively hopped and dry-hopped, but still balanced.

Dirty Dick's Nut Brown - Nut Brown Ale - A mildly hopped, mellow brown ale with hints of hazelnuts.

Bear All Pale Ale - American Pale Ale - A refreshing, but relatively hoppy American pale ale.

Winter Warmer - Spiced Beer - This dark and rich mahogany-colored ale is flavored with ginger, nutmeg and cinnamon.

Head Hunter IPA - American IPA - Head Hunter is an aggressively dry-hopped, West Coast IPA with a huge hop display of pine, grapefruit, citrus and pineapple. A punch-you-in-the-mouth brew for those who truly love their hops. Uncivilized? Yes. Aggressive? Absolutely. Award Winning? Hell yes!

BumbleBerry - Fruit Beer - Brewed with fresh harvested spring honey stolen from some very angry bees and infused with fresh blueber-

ries. A light, refreshing ale with a nice blueberry aroma, crackery malt flavors, a hint of sweetness and a refreshing blueberry finish.

Oompa Loompa Chocolate Cream Stout - Sweet Stout - The golden ticket to luscious indulgence. Brewed in small batches with Belgian Dark Chocolate and Madagascar Vanilla Beans to yield giant aromas and flavors of dark chocolate, roasted malt, caramel and vanilla with a creamy mouthfeel and bittersweet finish.

Holly Jolly Christmas Ale - Spiced Ale - A festive spiced holiday ale that warms the spirit and brings good cheer to all that partake. Cinnamon, ginger, honey, coriander, nutmeg and orange peel spice this ale and capture the flavors and aromas of Christmas. Both naughty and nice at the same, so be good for goodness sake

Secret Stache - Robust Stout - Specialty ingredients, including vanilla bean and lactose, lend to Secret Stache's complexity and full flavor. While no actual chocolate was used to brew this beer, heaps of chocolate malt give the beer its color as well as its chocolate and coffee notes.

Fascist Pig - Imperial Amber - Fascist Pig is a deep red, malt-forward ale brewed with plenty of caramel malts and a touch of rye for a hint of spice. This big American red ale is brewed and dry-hopped with palisade, an earthy and somewhat floral, mentholated American variety, and Zythos, an American blend that leans strongly toward Amarillo, Simcoe and Cascade varieties.

312 - Wheat Ale - Inspired by the city of Chicago and densely populated with flavor, 312's spicy aroma of Cascade hops is followed by a crisp, fruity ale flavor delivered in a smooth, creamy body that's immensely refreshing.

Matilda - Belgian Pale Ale - Wild in character, with a slightly fruity aroma and a spicy yeast flavor that is as unique as it is satisfying—Matilda is an intriguing choice for beer and wine lovers alike. Dry and quenching, it's the perfect accompaniment at the dining table or for casually socializing at the bar.

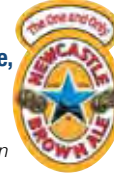
